Structural Proposal II

Name

Consolidated Municipality of Mundel, or whatever.

Governing Body

Nine members, including the municipal executive, who presides and votes. The other eight members will be elected from compact districts created as closely as possible from all-urban or all-rural areas. Elections could be nonpartisan.

Executive

Municipal executive, elected at large for a four-year term. Municipal elections would be held as they are now, in the year before the presidential election, to avoid the influence of state and national campaigns. Election could be nonpartisan.

Municipal administrator, appointed by and answerable to the municipal executive.

Qualifications for the municipal administrator will be established by ordinance adopted by the legislative body.

- III. Courts will function as they function now, supported by the separately elected County Clerk, who will assume the duties of the City Clerk.

- V. Effects on existing governments.
 - A. The City of Muncie, and the County of Delaware, would be eliminated as separate governmental entities. All of their present governmental functions would be subsooned under the new "Municipality of Mundel."
 - B. Streams of revenue dedicated to a particular function will follow that function. Only those citizens who receive the benefit of a governmental function will be taxed for that benefit.
